Matthew 25:14-21

Proverbs 4:7 reads, *“Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.”* (KJV) This verse reveals the importance of individuals obtaining as much knowledge as possible about various subjects. One area that churches should ensure their members are keenly aware of is money. The Word of God, from Genesis to Revelation, has much to say about finances. This lesson is designed to share some common knowledge about money that all Christians should possess.

1. You should know money is to be Secured Legally .
Proverbs 12:11
“He who tills his land will have plenty of bread, But he who follows worthless things lacks common sense and good judgment.” (AMP)

2. You should know money is to be Saved Intentionally .
Proverbs 13:22
“Good people leave an inheritance to their grandchildren, but the sinner’s wealth passes to the godly” (NLT)

3. You should know money is to be Shared Sacrificially .
Proverbs 19:17
“Giving help to the poor is like loaning money to the Lord. He will pay you back for your kindness.” (ERV)

4. You should know money is to be Spent Wisely .
Proverbs 31:16
“She considereth a field, and buyeth it:..” (KJV)

5. You should know money is to be Sown Biblically .
Deuteronomy 12:11
“Then to the place the Lord your God will choose as a dwelling for his Name—there you are to bring everything I command you: your burnt offerings and sacrifices, your tithes and special gifts, and all the choice possessions you have vowed to the Lord.” (NIV)
