Judges 14:1-5**

I Peter 2:17a reads, "Show respect for all people. Love your brothers and sisters in God's family..." (ERV) This verse reveals two commands for all believers. Verses 1-4

"One day when Samson was in Timnah, one of the Philistine women caught his eye. 2) When he returned home, he told his father and mother, "A young Philistine woman in Timnah caught my eye. I want to marry her. Get her for me." 3) His father and mother objected. "Isn't there even one woman in our tribe or among all the Israelites you could marry?" they asked. "Why must you go to the pagan Philistines to find a wife?" But Samson told his father, "Get her for me! She looks good to me." 4) His father and mother didn't realize the LORD was at work in this, creating an opportunity to work against the Philistines, who ruled over Israel at that time." (NLT)
