Disrespecting God by Disrespecting His People

1. _____ of God's people can be disrespectful to the Lord.
Verses 1, 2
"After this presentation to Israel's leaders, Moses and Aaron went and spoke to Pharaoh. They told him, "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: Let my people go so they may hold a festival in my honor in the wilderness." 2) "Is that so?" retorted Pharaoh. "And who is the LORD? Why should I listen to him and let Israel go? I don't know the LORD, and I will not let Israel go." (NLT)
2. _____ of God's people can be disrespectful to the Lord.
Verses 9-11
"Load them down with more work. Make them sweat! That will teach them to listen to lies!" 10) So the slave drivers and foremen went out and told the people: "This is what Pharaoh says: I will not provide any more straw for you. 11) Go and get it yourselves. Find it wherever you can. But you must produce just as many bricks as before!" (NLT)

3. _____ towards God's people can be disrespectful to the Lord.
Verses 13, 14
"Meanwhile, the Egyptian slave drivers continued to push hard. "Meet your daily quota of bricks, just as you did when we provided you with straw!" they demanded. 14) Then they whipped the Israelite foremen they had put in charge of the work crews. "Why haven't you met your quotas either yesterday or today?" they demanded." (NLT)
