**Steps to Become Loyal to Christ**  
**Luke 19:1-5**

Luke 9:23 reads, *“Then he said to the crowd, “If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me.”*(NLT) This verse reveals a threefold approach for anyone interested in developing a relationship with Christ. Once an individual becomes a Christian, they should then seek to grow in their knowledge about the Lord. Believers can accomplish this by coming up with practical ways to advance in their faith. This lesson is designed to share steps to become loyal to Christ by exploring an encounter with Jesus and Zacchaeus.
