Necessary Elements to Resolve Conflict with Family Members
Genesis 13:5-12

Romans 12:18 reads, *“If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.”* (NIV). This verse reveals how believers should operate in interpersonal relationships.
