Essential Elements Needed By Kingdom Men Acts 9:26-30

Genesis 2:18 reads, "Then the LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper as his complement." (HCSB) According to this verse, God desires for men to have companionship with those of the opposite sex. One mistake many males have made is limiting their interaction and involvement to only females. Within the Bible there are many examples of how males have teamed up to enrich one another's life. This lesson is designed to examine the ministry movements of Barnabas and Saul to point out essential elements needed by Kingdom men.

An essential element needed by Kingdom men is <u>Relationships</u>.
Acts 9:27

"Then Barnabas brought him to the apostles and told them how Saul had seen the Lord on the way to Damascus and how the Lord had spoken to Saul. He also told them that Saul had preached boldly in the name of Jesus in Damascus." (NLT)

An essential element needed by Kingdom men is <u>Fellowship</u>.
Acts 9:28

"So Saul stayed with the apostles..." (NLT)

An essential element needed by Kingdom men is <u>Partnership</u>. Acts 9:28

"...And went all around Jerusalem with them, preaching boldly in the name of the Lord." (NLT)

An essential element needed by Kingdom men is <u>Discipleship</u>.
Acts 11:25
"Then Parashas want on to Targue to look for Soul " (NILT)

"Then Barnabas went on to Tarsus to look for Saul." (NLT)

5.	An essential element needed by Kingdom men is <u>Leadership</u> . Acts 11:28-30
