Principles for Productive Soulwinning
Acts 10:44-48

Proverbs 11:30 reads, "... *He that winneth souls is wise.*" (KJV) This verse describes one positive characteristic about individuals who lead people to the Lord. The last words of Jesus to his disciples was for them to be witnesses to unbelievers. 21st Century followers of the Master are likewise commanded to do the same thing. This lesson is designed to examine an encounter between Peter and Cornelius to point out principles for productive soulwinning.

Verses 19-21

"Meanwhile, as Peter was puzzling over the vision, the Holy Spirit said to him, "Three men have come looking for you. 20) Get up, go downstairs, and go with them without hesitation. Don't worry, for I have sent them." 21) So Peter went down and said, "I'm the man you are looking for. Why have you come?" (NLT)

Verses 22, 23

"They said, "We were sent by Cornelius, a Roman officer. He is a devout and God-fearing man, well respected by all the Jews. A holy angel instructed him to summon you to his house so that he can hear your message." 23) So Peter invited the men to stay for the night. The next day he went with them, accompanied by some of the brothers from Joppa." (NLT)

Verses 25, 26

"As Peter entered his home, Cornelius fell at his feet and worshiped him. 26) But Peter pulled him up and said, "Stand up! I'm a human being just like you!" (NLT) (Over)
