General Information Witnesses for Christ Should Share
Acts 2:14-22

Matthew 28:18-20 read, "Then Jesus came to them and said, "All power in heaven and on earth is given to me. So go and make followers of all people in the world. Baptize them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach them to obey everything that I have taught you, and I will be with you always, even until the end of this age." (NCV) These verses reveal the assignment that was given to the disciples directly from the Master. All children of God should witness to unbelievers in an attempt to lead them to the Lord. One way of effectively carrying this out is for believers to share their knowledge about Jesus with people from all walks of life. This lesson is designed to point out general information witnesses for Christ should share.

1. Witnesses for Christ should share information about the **Actions** of Jesus.
Verse 22
"People of Israel, listen! God publicly endorsed Jesus the Nazarene by doing powerful miracles, wonders, and signs through him, as you well know." (NLT)

2. Witnesses for Christ should share information about the **Crucifixion** of Jesus.
Verse 23
"But God knew what would happen, and his prearranged plan was carried out when Jesus was betrayed. With the help of lawless Gentiles, you nailed him to a cross and killed him." (NLT)

3. Witnesses for Christ should share information about the **Resurrection** of Jesus.
Verse 24
"But God released him from the horrors of death and raised him back to life, for death could not keep him in its grip." (NLT)

4. Witnesses for Christ should share information about the **Ascension** of Jesus.
Verse 32
"God raised Jesus from the dead, and we are all witnesses of this." (NLT)
