**Promises for an Obedient Lifestyle**  
**Deuteronomy 28:1-10**

Numbers 23:19 reads, *“God is not a human being, and he will not lie. He is not a human, and he does not change his mind. What he says he will do, he does. What he promises, he makes come true.”* (NCV) This verse reveals four wonderful facts about the Lord. A noteworthy characteristic that all individuals should seek to display is being a person of their word. A failure to do so can lead to many acts of disobedience against humanity and divinity. This lesson is designed to share promises God makes to believers for an obedient lifestyle.

1. Separation is a promise from God for an obedient lifestyle.

**Verse 1**

*“If you fully obey the LORD your God and carefully keep all his commands that I am giving you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations of the world.”* (NLT)

2. Multiplication is a promise from God for an obedient lifestyle.

**Verses 4, 5**

*“You will have many children. You will harvest large crops, and your herds of cattle and flocks of sheep and goats will produce many young. 5) You will have plenty of bread to eat.”* (CEV)

3. Domination is a promise from God for an obedient lifestyle.

**Verse 7**

*“The LORD will help you defeat your enemies who come to fight against you. Your enemies will come against you one way, but they will run away from you seven different ways!”* (ERV)

4. Sanctification is a promise from God for an obedient lifestyle.

**Verses 9, 10**

*“If you obey the commands of the LORD your God and walk in his ways, the LORD will establish you as his holy people as he swore he would do. 10) Then all the nations of the world will see that you are a people claimed by the LORD, and they will stand in awe of you.”* (NLT)
