Common Occurrences That Happen During Church Worship
Luke 4:16-24

Acts 13:1 reads, "Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul." (NIV) These verses reveal what happened for a group of people while they were worshipping God corporately. There are many instances in the Bible where the lives of men and women were transformed as a result of being in church. Due to this, all believers should commit to doing all in their power to faithfully and physically being present in the Lord's house weekly. This lesson is designed to share common occurrences that can happen during church worship.

1. Participation from people is a common occurrence that can happen during church worship.
Verses 16-17
"He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read, 17) and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written:" (NIV)
2. Observation from people is a common occurrence that can happen during church worship.
Verse 20
"Then he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant and sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him." (NIV)
3. Revelation from people is a common occurrence that can happen during church worship.
Verse 21
"He began by saying to them, "Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." (NIV)
