A Church You Should Not Mind Attending
Acts 13:1-3

Acts 17:1, 2 read, *“Paul and Silas then traveled through the towns of Amphipolis and Apollonia and came to Thessalonica, where there was a Jewish synagogue. 2) As was Paul’s custom, he went to the synagogue service, and for three Sabbaths in a row he used the Scriptures to reason with the people.”* (NLT) These verses reveal a practice that was prioritized by a New Testament leader every Saturday. Most church leaders and members would be honored to have their local assembly filled with worshippers every week. There are many approaches churches can take to make their house of worship appealing to congregants and community residents. This lesson is designed to share elements of a church you should not mind attending.
