**Acts 8:29-35**

Romans 1:16 reads, *“I am not ashamed of the Good News, because it is the power God uses to save everyone who believes—to save the Jews first, and then to save non-Jews.”* (NCV) This verse reveals what one writer had no apprehension doing for the Lord. God desires for all Christians to share their faith with and around non-believers on a regular basis. 1. **Providence** \_\_\_\_\_ can help you to experience growth through witnessing.  
**Verses 26-28**  
*“An angel of the Lord spoke to Philip saying, “Get up and go south. Take the road that goes down from Jerusalem to the country of Gaza. It goes through the desert.” 27) Philip got up and went. A man from the country of Ethiopia had come to Jerusalem to worship. He had been made so he could not have children. He cared for all the riches that belonged to Candace who was Queen of Ethiopia. 28) As he was going back home, he was sitting in his wagon reading about the early preacher Isaiah.” (NLV)*
2. **Obedience** \_\_\_\_\_ can help you to experience growth through witnessing.  
**Verses 29, 30**  
*“The Holy Spirit said to Philip, “Go over to that wagon and get on it.” 30) Philip ran up to him. He saw that the man from Ethiopia was reading from the writings of the early preacher Isaiah and said, “Do you understand what you are reading?” (NLV)*
