Verses 10-13
"I said, 'What shall I do, Lord?' The Lord answered, 'Get up and go to Damascus. There you will be told about all the things I have planned for you to do.' 11) I could not see, because the bright light had made me blind. So my companions led me into Damascus. 12) "There a man named Ananias came to me. He was a religious man; he obeyed the law of Moses, and all the Jews who lived there respected him. 13) He stood by me and said, 'Brother Saul, see again!' Immediately I was able to see him." (NCV)
