I Kings 9:6-9

James 4:17 reads, "Remember, it is a sin to know what you ought to do and then not do it." (NLT) This verse reveals that those who know better should likewise do better. The first step for many children of God to live a life pleasing to the Lord is to discover what He wants. One desire of the Master is for all people on earth to worship Him solely and sincerely. 4. Devastation can come to families who stop worshipping God.
Verse 8
"This temple will become a heap of rubble. All who pass by will be appalled and will scoff and say, 'Why has the Lord done such a thing to this land and to this temple?' (NIV)
