Rev. Dr. Cynthia L. Hale is the founder and Senior Pastor of the Ray of Hope Christian Church in Decatur, Georgia. The Ray of Hope Christian Church is a congregation that has a vision to "impact and transform this present world into the Kingdom of God" through Housing, Healthcare and Education Initiatives.

Dr. Hale is a native of Roanoke, Virginia. Her natural talent in music led her to study at Hollins College in Virginia, where she received her Bachelor of Arts degree. She holds a Master of Divinity degree from Duke University and a Doctor of Ministry from United Theological Seminary, Dayton, Ohio. Additionally, she holds five Honorary Doctor of Divinity degrees and one Honorary Doctor of Law degree.

As a woman of vision, Dr. Hale is revered locally, nationally, and internationally for her leadership, integrity, and compassion. In 2004, Dr. Hale established a mentoring program known as Elah Pastoral Ministries, Inc. to assist in the spiritual as well as practical development of pastors and para-church leaders. In September 2005, she convened her first Women in Ministry Conference; a premiere, national conference with a focused mission to Develop, Coach and Mentor Christian Women in Ministry for the 21st Century. Dr. Hale presently serves on the Board of Trustees at Hollins University, as the Chairperson of the Board of Directors at Beulah Heights University, Chairperson of the Board of Directors for the City of Hope Ministries, Inc., and is the Secretary for the Hampton University Ministers' Conference.

As a recipient of numerous honors and recognitions, Dr. Hale was inducted into the African American Biographies Hall of Fame and the Martin Luther King Board of Preachers of Morehouse College. In July 2009, Dr. Hale was appointed by President Barack Obama to serve on the President's Commission on White House Fellowships. In January 2010, she authored her first book entitled; I'm A Piece of Work: Sisters Shaped by God. Dr. Hale is a dedicated active member of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.

Dr. Hale is a contributing writer for many books and publications including the books, Power in the Pulpit II: How America's Most Effective Black Preachers Prepare Their Sermons and the preaching resource series, Feasting on the Gospels. Dr. Hale has been in ministry for 38 years. Her ministerial gift has drawn thousands, young and old, to witness the anointing of a woman totally sold out for the Kingdom of God.

Dr. Sedric D. Veal, Sr. was born on October 4, 1972 to the late Mrs. Marsha F. Veal of Leland, MS. His grandmother, the late Rosie McGill raised him. His new birth experience took place May 1980 at Pilgrim Home Church in Leland, MS. In December 1989, he went from practicing & pretending to preach to actually being chosen by God at age of 17. His initial sermon was preached on January 28, 1990 at Zion Progressive Church in Leland under the tutelage of Dr. Charles E. Williams. Veal was ordained May 1990.

Currently, Dr. Veal is the proud pastor of Temple Baptist Church. Under his leadership, he has transitioned The Historical Temple Baptist Church into a 44,000 sq. ft. edifice, established a Food Pantry that serves hundreds of families/individuals monthly, established a Social Development Ministry that provides assistance to members of Temple and the community, and opened Temple Bookstore.

Dr. Veal is a graduate of the American Association of Christian Counselors, and he possesses a Pastoral Studies certificate from Louisiana Baptist University. He received both his Master's and Doctoral degrees in Theology from Slidell Baptist Seminary. Additionally, he is pursuing his PH. D. at Louisiana Baptist University. He is also an affiliate of the National Baptist Convention and the Southern Baptist Convention. Dr. Veal preaches many revivals, crusades, and lectures annually throughout the world. Additionally, he has preached in the National Baptist Convention, USA.

Dr. Veal is currently in the process of completing his first book with Westbow Publishing Company. He is a devoted father to Sedric, Sadrissia, Shandrea, Brittney & Olivia.

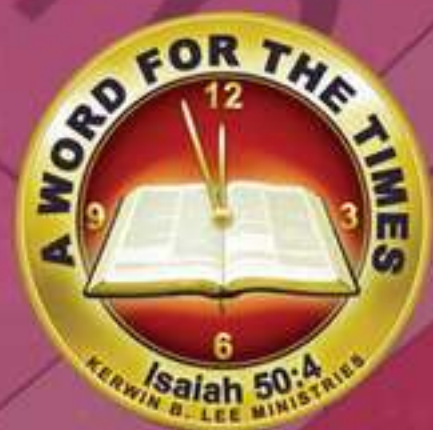
