Representing Christ to People in Need

Luke 10:30-37

II Corinthians 5:20 reads, "So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead. "Come back to God!" (NLT) This verse records the job title and main task of every individual who has accepted Jesus as their personal Saviour. A prime time to witness to unbelievers is when they are in the midst of crisis and calamity. Countless numbers of people without Christ have been won to the Lord because a believer was there for them at a critical time in life. This lesson is designed to share how you can represent Christ to people who are in need.

1. You can represent Christ by providing Respect to people in need.
Verses 33, 34
"Then a Samaritan traveling down the road came to where the hurt man was. When he saw the man, he felt very sorry for him. 34) The Samaritan went to him..." (NCV)
2. You can represent Christ by providing Relief to people in need.
Verse 34
"...poured olive oil and wine on his wounds, and bandaged them." (NCV)
3. You can represent Christ by providing Resuscitation to people in need.
Verse 34
"...Then he put the hurt man on his own donkey and took him to an inn where he cared for him." (NCV)
4. You can represent Christ by providing Resources to people in need.
Verse 35
"The next day, the Samaritan brought out two coins, gave them to the innkeeper..." (NCV)
