Romans 5:1-10

1. Believers should know that Jesus’ death on the cross brought **Justification** to them.

Verse 1

“Therefore, since we have been made right in God’s sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us.” (NLT)

2. Believers should know that Jesus’ death on the cross brought **Expectation** to them.

Verse 2

“Because of our faith, Christ has brought us into this place of undeserved privilege where we now stand, and we confidently and joyfully look forward to sharing God’s glory.” (NLT)

3. Believers should know that Jesus’ death on the cross brought **Jubilation** to them.

Verse 3

We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance.” (NLT)
