Inappropriate Behavior That Can Ruin Your Success Spiritually

I Kings 1:5-10

I Timothy 4:12 reads, "Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity." (NIV) This verse reveals the type of traits that children of God should exhibit regardless of their age. No believer should ever be guilty of their gift opening up doors that their character closes. In order to prevent this from happening, there is knowledge that individuals must possess and apply. This lesson is designed to share inappropriate behavior that can ruin your success spiritually.

1. Wrong Assumptions in life is behavior that can ruin your success spiritually.

Verse 5

"About that time David's son Adonijah, whose mother was Haggith, began boasting, "I will make myself king." So he provided himself with chariots and charioteers and recruited fifty men to run in front of him." (NLT)

2. Wrong Omissions in life is behavior that can ruin your success spiritually.

Verse 6

"Now his father, King David, had never disciplined him at any time, even by asking, "Why are you doing that?" Adonijah had been born next after Absalom, and he was very handsome." (NLT)

3. Wrong Companions in life is behavior that can ruin your success spiritually.

Verse 7

"Adonijah took Joab son of Zeruah and Abiathar the priest into his confidence, and they agreed to help him become king." (NLT)
