What Money Cannot Do for You

Mark 10:17-25

Ecclesiastes 10:19 reads, "A feast is made for laughter, wine makes life merry, and money is the answer for everything." This verse records a common misconception about the use of finances. Even in the 21st Century there are still individuals who believe that their currency can provide them with whatever they need. People should not be fooled into thinking that even with all the riches in this world, they will not have their share of problems in life. This lesson is designed to share what money cannot do for you.
