Nehemiah 4:1-6

Ezra 5:8 reads, “We went to Judah, where the temple of the great God is being built with huge stones and wooden beams set in the walls. Everyone is working hard, and the building is going up quickly.” (CEV) This verse records the report that was given to King Darius about the progress of the construction project going on in Jerusalem. 1. You can prepare others for success by Synergizing them.
Verse 6
“So we rebuilt the wall to half its height, because the people were willing to work.” (NCV)

2. You can prepare others for success by Mobilizing them.
Verse 13
“So I put people behind the lowest places along the wall—the open places—and I put families together with their swords, spears, and bows.” (NCV)

3. You can prepare others for success by Energizing them.
Verse 14
“Then I looked around and stood up and said to the important men, the leaders, and the rest of the people: “Don’t be afraid of them. Remember the Lord, who is great and powerful. Fight for your brothers, your sons and daughters, your wives, and your homes.” (NCV)
