Teamwork Needed to Tackle a Tough Task

Nehemiah 2:12-20

Leviticus 26:8 reads, “Five of you will chase a hundred, and a hundred of you will chase ten thousand, and your enemies will fall by the sword before you.” (NIV) This verse records two promises God made to the children of Israel while they were in the wilderness. An examination of both of them points out the value of individuals working together. Many noteworthy projects never were accomplished due to a failure of collaboration to take place from the stakeholders. This lesson is designed to share teamwork that is needed to tackle a tough task.

Verses 13, 14

“By night I went out through the Valley Gate toward the Jackal Well and the Dung Gate, examining the walls of Jerusalem, which had been broken down, and its gates, which had been destroyed by fire. 14) Then I moved on toward the Fountain Gate and the King’s Pool, but there was not enough room for my mount to get through;” (NIV)

Verses 16, 17

“The officials did not know where I had gone or what I was doing, because as yet I had said nothing to the Jews or the priests or nobles or officials or any others who would be doing the work. 17) Then I said to them, “You see the trouble we are in: Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been burned with fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, and we will no longer be in disgrace.” (NIV)
