Helping Others Overcome Physical Challenges

1. Your **Integrity** towards others can help them overcome physical challenges.

Verses 14-16

“For the entire twelve years that I was governor of Judah— from the twentieth year to the thirty-second year of the reign of King Artaxerxes —neither I nor my officials drew on our official food allowance. 15) The former governors, in contrast, had laid heavy burdens on the people, demanding a daily ration of food and wine, besides forty pieces of silver. Even their assistants took advantage of the people. But because I feared God, I did not act that way. 16) I also devoted myself to working on the wall and refused to acquire any load. And I required all my servants to spend time working on the wall.” (NLT)

“I asked for nothing, even though I regularly fed 150 Jewish officials at my table, besides all the visitors from other lands!” (NLT)
