I Samuel 30:1-6

Verses 11, 13, 14

He said, "I am an Egyptian, the slave of an Amalekite. My master abandoned me when I became ill three days ago. 14) We raided the Negev of the Kerethites, some territory belonging to Judah and the Negev of Caleb. And we burned Ziklag." (NIV)
