I Just Got A Miracle, Now What?

**John 5:8-15**

Mark 10:52 reads, "And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way." (KJV) This verse records what Bartimaeus did as soon as he obtained a miracle from the Master. Throughout the Bible there are many portraits of men and women who experienced supernatural breakthroughs and the way they responded. *"At once the man was cured; he picked up his mat **and walked**. The day on which this took place was a Sabbath."* (NIV)
3. You should be willing to **Stand** \_\_\_\_\_ for the Lord after experiencing a miracle.  
**Verse 10, 11**  
*"And so the Jewish leaders said to the man who had been healed, "It is the Sabbath; the law forbids you to carry your mat. 11) But he replied, "The man who made me well said to me, 'Pick up your mat and walk.'" (NIV)*
4. You should be willing to **Stop** \_\_\_\_\_ for the Lord after experiencing a miracle.

*"Later Jesus found him at the temple and said to him, "See, you are well again. Stop sinning or something worse may happen to you."* (NIV)
