**Are You A Part of the Solution or the Problem?**

**Luke 10:30-37**

Daniel 5:16 reads, *“Now I have heard that you are able to give interpretations and to solve difficult problems. If you can read this writing and tell me what it means, you will be clothed in purple and have a gold chain placed around your neck, and you will be made the third highest ruler in the kingdom.”* (NIV) This verse records the occasion an Old Testament leader had to use his skillset for the benefit of someone else. Every believer possesses spiritual gifts from the Lord in order to make a positive impact for God’s glory. Individuals who refuse to use their gifting rob themselves of an opportunity to bless others and advance Kingdom causes.
