Can I Get A Little Help Here

Mark 6:32-37

Psalm 121:1, 2 read, *“I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. 2) My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.”* (KJV) These verses reveal where one Old Testament writer sought to find aid during his life journey. No individual can exist successfully without others coming along side of them in some way. A failure to recognize this may result in people trying to do too much on their own. This lesson is designed to share how Jesus can provide for your life.

1. Jesus can provide **Balance** _____ for your life.
Verses 30, 31

“The apostles returned to Jesus from their ministry tour and told him all they had done and taught. 31) Then Jesus said, “Let’s go off by ourselves to a quiet place and rest awhile.” He said this because there were so many people coming and going that Jesus and his apostles didn’t even have time to eat.” (NLT)

2. Jesus can provide **Assistance** _____ for your life.
Verses 35, 36, 41-44

“Late in the afternoon his disciples came to him and said, “This is a remote place, and it’s already getting late. 36) Send the crowds away so they can go to the nearby farms and villages and buy something to eat.” 41) Jesus took the five loaves and two fish, looked up toward heaven, and blessed them. Then, breaking the loaves into pieces, he kept giving the bread to the disciples so they could distribute it to the people. He also divided the fish for everyone to share. 42) They all ate as much as they wanted, 43) and afterward, the disciples picked up twelve baskets of leftover bread and fish. 44) A total of 5,000 men and their families were fed.” (NLT)
