1. **Starting** _____ with **Prerequisites** _____ can prevent you from voting for the wrong candidate.

Verses 21, 22

“So now we must choose a replacement for Judas from among the men who were with us the entire time we were traveling with the Lord Jesus—22) from the time he was baptized by John until the day he was taken from us...” (NLT)

2. **Standing** _____ on **Principles** _____ can prevent you from voting for the wrong candidate.

Verse 22

“... Whoever is chosen will join us as a witness of Jesus’ resurrection.” (NLT)

3. **Sticking** _____ to **Prayer** _____ can prevent you from voting for the wrong candidate.

Verses 23-26

“So they nominated two men: Joseph called Barsabbas (also known as Justus) and Matthias. 24) Then they all prayed, “O Lord, you know every heart. Show us which of these men you have chosen 25) as an apostle to replace Judas in this ministry, for he has deserted us and gone where he belongs.” 26) Then they cast lots, and Matthias was selected to become an apostle with the other eleven.” (NLT)
