“Then the LORD spoke to Jonah a second time: 2) “Get up and go to the great city of Nineveh, and deliver the message I have given you.” 3) This time Jonah obeyed the LORD’s command and went to Nineveh, a city so large that it took three days to see it all.” (NLT)

“On the day Jonah entered the city, he shouted to the crowds: “Forty days from now Nineveh will be destroyed!” (NLT)
