Colossians 1:15-20

Matthew 2:1, 2 read, "Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, 2) saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him." (NKJV) These verses record an encounter a Roman official had with individuals who were in pursuit of Jesus.
