**Mark 14:3-9**

Galatians 1:10 reads, *"I am not trying to please people. I want to please God. Do you think I am trying to please people? If I were doing that, I would not be a servant of Christ."* (CEV) This verse records Apostle Paul's primary goal as he preached the Gospel of Jesus.
