**“Just Do Your Job”**

**Matthew 20:8-12**

John 9:4 reads, “*We must quickly carry out the tasks assigned us by the one who sent us. The night is coming, and then no one can work.*” (NLT) This verse records words Jesus spoke about himself and others to his disciples. One commodity that is poorly used by many employees is time. Often this takes place because of individuals seeking to please other laborers more than their employer. This lesson is designed to share what can help believers focus on doing their job in the place of employment.

1. Don't **Conclude** \_\_\_\_\_ regarding others in order to focus on doing your job.  
**Verse 10**  
*“So when those came who were hired first, they expected to receive more. But each one of them also received a denarius.”* (NIV)
  
2. Don't **Complain** \_\_\_\_\_ about others in order to focus on doing your job.  
**Verse 11**  
*“When they received it, they began to grumble against the landowner.”* (NIV)
  
3. Don't **Compete** \_\_\_\_\_ with others in order to focus on doing your job.  
**Verse 12**  
*““These who were hired last worked only one hour,’ they said, ‘and you have made them equal to us who have borne the burden of the work and the heat of the day.”* (NIV)
