“Ain’t No Stopping Him Now”

Mark 5:28-34

I Thessalonians 5:23, 24 read, “*We pray that God himself, the God of peace, will make you pure—belonging only to him. We pray that your whole self—spirit, soul, and body—will be kept safe and be blameless when our Lord Jesus Christ comes.* 24) *The one who chose you will do that for you. You can trust him.*” (ERV) These verses record Apostle Paul’s prayer and promise regarding the total being of the believers in Thessalonica. There are many examples of people in the Bible being set free spiritually, mentally, and physically. The same power that was displayed by God to others in ancient times is still available for Christians today. This lesson is designed to share the authority Jesus has to improve your physical body.
