1. Faith that **Perceives** _____ when it comes to Jesus brings about victory.

Verses 46, 47

“Then they reached Jericho, and as Jesus and his disciples left town, a large crowd followed him. A blind beggar named Bartimaeus (son of Timaeus) was sitting beside the road. 47) When Bartimaeus heard that Jesus of Nazareth was nearby, he began to shout, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” (NLT)

2. Faith that **Believes** _____ when it comes to Jesus brings about victory.

Verses 49, 50

“When Jesus heard him, he stopped and said, “Tell him to come here.” So they called the blind man. “Cheer up,” they said. “Come on, he’s calling you!” 50) Bartimaeus threw aside his coat, jumped up, and came to Jesus.” (NLT)

3. Faith that **Receives** _____ when it comes to Jesus brings about victory.

Verses 51, 52

“What do you want me to do for you?” Jesus asked. “My Rabbi,” the blind man said, “I want to see! 52) And Jesus said to him, “Go, for your faith has healed you.” Instantly the man could see, and he followed Jesus down the road.” (NLT)
