Luke 2:41-52

I Corinthians 15:57 reads, *“But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”* (KJV) This verse records that living triumphantly as a believer is possible because of the Savior of the world. Being victorious in life should not just be restricted to people who are engaged in sporting activities. 1. Proper Recreation is a key element for families to experience victory.
Verses 41, 42
“Every year Jesus’ parents went to Jerusalem for the Festival of the Passover. 42) When he was twelve years old, they went up to the festival, according to the custom.” (NIV)
2. Proper Prioritization is a key element for families to experience victory.
Verses 43-46
“After the festival was over, while his parents were returning home, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem, but they were unaware of it. 44) Thinking he was in their company, they traveled on for a day. Then they began looking for him among their relatives and friends. 45) When they did not find him, they went back to Jerusalem to look for him. 46) After three days they found him in the temple courts, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions.” (NIV)
