Psalm 107:1-7

Acts 4:18-20 read, "So they called the apostles back in and commanded them never again to speak or teach in the name of Jesus. 19) But Peter and John replied, "Do you think God wants us to obey you rather than him? 20) We cannot stop telling about everything we have seen and heard." (NLT) These verses record the response two followers of Jesus had regarding them not talking about the Master. All believers should willingly, boldly and publicly share with others the goodness of the Lord. A failure to do so will always hinder people from becoming disciples for Jesus.
