“Do It for The Lord and Others”

Acts 9:10-17

Luke 2:52 reads, “*And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man.*” (NIV) This verse records who was prioritized by the Master while he was on earth. A major goal of every Christian should be to live in harmony with God and people. Failure to do both will always jeopardize one's blessings in this world and rewards in heaven. 1. Your readjusting for the Lord can lead to others being Accommodated .
Verses 18, 19
“Instantly something like scales fell from Saul’s eyes, and he regained his sight. Then he got up and was baptized. 19) Afterward he ate some food and regained his strength. Saul stayed with the believers in Damascus for a few days.”

2. Your readjusting for the Lord can lead to others being Assisted .
Verse 25
“So during the night, some of the other believers lowered him in a large basket through an opening in the city wall.”
(NLT)
3. Your readjusting for the Lord can lead to others being Approved .
Verses 26, 27
“When Saul arrived in Jerusalem, he tried to meet with the believers, but they were all afraid of him. They did not believe he had truly become a believer! 27) Then Barnabas brought him to the apostles and told them how Saul had seen the Lord on the way to Damascus and how the Lord had spoken to Saul. He also told them that Saul had preached boldly in the name of Jesus in Damascus.”
