“Readjusting for the Redeemer”

Luke 24:28-34

Matthew 2:12 reads, *“When it was time to leave, they returned to their own country by another route, for God had warned them in a dream not to return to Herod.”* (NLT) This verse records changes a group of wise men were willing to make after seeing Jesus. One of the most difficult tasks for many people is to make change from habits and practices they have grown comfortable doing. Believers who have a growing relationship with God also have His power in them to be able to make necessary changes in their life. This lesson is designed to share adjustments you should be willing to make for the Master.

3. All believers should be willing to adjust their Temperament for the Master.

Verse 17

“He asked them, “What are you discussing together as you walk along?” They stood still, their faces downcast.”

Verse 32

“They asked each other, “Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?”

4. All believers should be willing to adjust their Judgement for the Master.

Verse 19

“What things?” he asked. “About Jesus of Nazareth,” they replied. “He was a prophet, powerful in word and deed before God and all the people.”
