**Mark 6:6-13**

Ruth 1:6 reads, *“Then Naomi heard in Moab that the LORD had blessed his people in Judah by giving them good crops again. So Naomi and her daughters-in-law got ready to leave Moab to return to her homeland.”* (NLT) This verse records the transition a family of three is about to make from one city to another.
