“People You Should Run From As Soon As Possible”

I Samuel 19:11-18

Matthew 10:14 reads, *“If anyone will not welcome you or listen to your words, leave that home or town and shake the dust off your feet.”* (NIV) This verse records words from Jesus to the disciples regarding being rejected by others. People from all walks of life need wise counsel on resolving conflict with individuals. A failure for one to gain and follow sage advice, can lead to ungodly behavior. This lesson is designed to share the type of people you should run from as soon as possible.

1. You should run as soon as possible from people who are Negative .
I Samuel 18:8, 9
“This made Saul very angry. “What’s this?” he said. “They credit David with ten thousands and me with only thousands. Next they’ll be making him their king!” 9) So from that time on Saul kept a jealous eye on David.”

2. You should run as soon as possible from people who are Combative .
I Samuel 18:10, 11
“The very next day a tormenting spirit from God overwhelmed Saul, and he began to rave in his house like a madman. David was playing the harp, as he did each day. But Saul had a spear in his hand, 11) and he suddenly hurled it at David, intending to pin him to the wall. But David escaped him twice.”
