II Kings 5:4-14

Judges 4:10 reads, “At Kedesh, Barak called together the tribes of Zebulun and Naphtali, and 10,000 warriors went up with him. Deborah also went with him.” (NLT) This verse records a group of people in the Old Testament who teamed up to gain the victory over their enemy. No one regardless of their resourcefulness, skillfulness, or courageousness wins battles on their own. Being successful in any arena of life always requires cooperation with and collaboration from other people. This lesson is designed to share what you and others can do to assist in your recovery.
