- 1. Acts of **Destruction** must be addressed sooner than later to preserve order in the church.

Verses 17, 18

"In the things I tell you now I do not praise you, because when you come together you do more harm than good. 18) First, I hear that when you meet together as a church you are divided, and I believe some of this."

2. Acts of **Deception** must be addressed sooner than later to preserve order in the church.

Verses 20, 21

"When you come together, you are not really eating the Lord's Supper.21) This is because when you eat, each person eats without waiting for the others. Some people do not get enough to eat, while others have too much to drink."

3. Acts of **Degradation** must be addressed sooner than later to preserve order in the church.

Verse 22

"You can eat and drink in your own homes! You seem to think God's church is not important, and you embarrass those who are poor. What should I tell you? Should I praise you? I do not praise you for doing this."
