**“Keys to Release Family Members Out of Bondage”**

**1 Samuel 30:15-19**

Genesis 14:14 reads, "When Abram learned that Lot had been captured, he called out his 318 trained men who had been born in his camp. He led the men and chased the enemy all the way to the town of Dan." (NCV) This verse records what an uncle was willing to do for a nephew who was in serious trouble. Throughout history, all families have had their share of pains and problems. However, the way family members respond to household matters can either help or hurt their immediate circle. This lesson is designed to share key components to help release family members out of bondage.

1. **Assurance** can help family members to be released from bondage.

**Verse 6**

“And David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.”

(KJV)

2. **Guidance** can help family members to be released from bondage.

**Verses 7, 8**

“And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David. 8) And David enquired at the LORD, saying, Shall I pursue after this troop? shall I overtake them? And he answered him, Pursue: for thou shalt surely overtake them, and without fail recover all.”

(KJV)

3. **Obedience** can help family members to be released from bondage.

**Verse 9**

“**So David went**, he and the six hundred men that were with him, and came to the brook Besor, where those that were left behind stayed.”
