# "Little Things That Make A Big Difference"

#### Acts 9:25-30

Luke 16:10 reads, "Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much......" (NIV) This verse records words spoken by Jesus on the subject of stewardship. Every believer should have a deep desire to use their resources to make people a priority. There are various ways to show others that they are important to you. This lesson is designed to share common small acts that can make a big difference in the lives of others.

#### Breakdown of Acts 9:1-30

- 1. You can prioritize people by \_\_\_\_\_\_ for them. Genesis 14:12-16

"They also captured Lot—Abram's nephew who lived in Sodom—and carried off everything he owned. 13) But one of Lot's men escaped and reported everything to Abram the Hebrew, who was living near the oak grove belonging to Mamre the Amorite. Mamre and his relatives, Eshcol and Aner, were Abram's allies. 14) When Abram heard that his nephew Lot had been captured, he mobilized the 318 trained men who had been born into his household. Then he pursued Kedorlaomer's army until he caught up with them at Dan. 15) There he divided his men and attacked during the night. Kedorlaomer's army fled, but Abram chased them as far as Hobah, north of Damascus. 16) Abram recovered all the goods that had been taken, and he brought back his nephew Lot with his possessions and all the women and other captives." (NLT)

2. You can prioritize people by \_\_\_\_\_\_ regarding them. **1 Samuel 19:4** 

"The next morning Jonathan spoke with his father about David, saying many good things about him. "The king must not sin against his servant David," Jonathan said. "He's never done anything to harm you. He has always helped you in any way he could." (NLT)

- 3. You can prioritize people by \_\_\_\_\_\_ around them. Job 2:11-13 "When three of Job's friends heard of the tragedy he had suffered, they got together and traveled from their homes to comfort and console him. Their names were Eliphaz the Temanite, Bildad the Shuhite, and Zophar the Naamathite. 12) When they saw Job from a distance, they scarcely recognized him. Wailing loudly, they tore their robes and threw dust into the air over their heads to show their grief. 13) Then they sat on the ground with him for seven days and nights. No one said a word to Job, for they saw that his suffering was too great for words." (NLT)
- 4. You can prioritize people by \_\_\_\_\_\_ with them. **Ezekiel 3:15** *"Then I came to the colony of Judean exiles in Tel-abib, beside the Kebar Ri*

"Then I came to the colony of Judean exiles in Tel-abib, beside the Kebar River. I was overwhelmed and sat among them for seven days." (NLT)

5. You can prioritize people by \_\_\_\_\_\_ about them.

#### Acts 9:26-28

"When Saul arrived in Jerusalem, he tried to meet with the believers, but they were all afraid of him. They did not believe he had truly become a believer! 27) Then Barnabas brought him to the apostles and told them how Saul had seen the Lord on the way to Damascus and how the Lord had spoken to Saul. He also told them that Saul had preached boldly in the name of Jesus in Damascus. 28) So Saul stayed with the apostles and went all around Jerusalem with them, preaching boldly in the name of the Lord." (NLT)
